




Battery Replacement: Standard AES

Tools Required: None

- 1** Locate your main control unit. It will likely be in a basement, closet, or crawl space, and may be grey, beige, or black in color. For AES radio, the unit will be on a higher level in the home and will have an antenna coming out of the top.



- 2** Open the door to the main control/AES. If you do not have a key, check the top of the control unit.



- 3** Disconnect the black and red connectors from the top of the old battery.

- 4** Install the new battery in its place and reconnect black wire to black lead and red wire to red lead.
